Year 2	Ourselves Includes the lessons: Exploring sounds; using voices to describe feelings and mood; create and notate vocal sounds; perform Toys Includes the lessons: Move and play to a steady beat and to sound sequences; control changing tempo	Our Land Includes the lessons: Exploring sounds; timbre and texture for descriptive sounds; listen to and perform music inspired by myths Our Bodies Includes the lessons: Develop a steady beat using their bodies; respond to music and play rhythm patterns on body percussion and instruments	Animals Includes the lessons: Link animal movement with pitch movement to recognise change in pitch; interpret pitch line notation with voices and instruments. Number Includes the lessons: explore steady beat and rhythm patterns; play beats and patterns and create body percussion.	Storytime Includes the lessons: Exploring sounds; introduce to famous pieces to stimulate composition; interpret a storyboard with sound effects. Seasons Includes the lessons: Understand pitch through movement, songs and listening games;	Weather Includes the lessons: create descriptive sounds and word rhythms with raps and songs; create descriptive class composition Pattern Includes the lessons: Use simple notations to play and create rhythms suing percussion	Water Includes the lessons: Sing and play a variety of pitch shapes using movement from scores; create a class composition.
