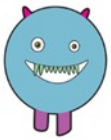
Phonics Screening Check

Reading

Year one

- Read simple sentences with fluency and expression.
- Read accurately by blending unfamiliar words.
- Retell stories they have read, making links to their own experiences
- Know all 40 sounds.

Year Two

- Reads fluently, using phonics knowledge with unfamiliar words.
- Self correct reading and read with expressions
- Make simple inferences on what they have read
- Ask and answer simple questions about what they have read, looking in the text for answers.

- ▶ Writing Process

Writing

Year one

- Write a simple sentence using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces and 'and'.
- Use question and exclamation marks.
- Form all letters correctly.
- Make phonetically plausible attempts at words

Year two

- Use a range of conjunctions 'and' 'but' 'because' 'so' 'or' 'if' 'when'
- Use question marks, exclamation marks, apostrophes, commas in writing.
- Words are the correct size and formed correctly, some joining tails.
- Edit their own work.

Maths

Year one

- Count forwards and backwards to 100.
- Add and subtract to 20 using objects, pictures and mentally.
- Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10's.
- Name the 2D and 3D shapes.
- Tell the time to half past.
- Recognise all the coins.

Year two

- Count forwards and backwards to 100, in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
- Add and subtract to 100 using objects, pictures and mentally.
- Know and use the 2, 3, 5 and 10 x tables.
- Name the 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- Tell the time.
- Recognise all the coins and use these to make different amounts.
